## **Application for Student Travel Assistance Grant**

A limited number of travel assistance grants will be available for NAS 2014 student authors. Priority will be given to students who would otherwise be unable to attend the conference to present their own work. The students who receive the grants can be offered three-day free accommodations closed to conference venue. Notification of the grants will be made in late July. To qualify for a student travel assistance grant, a recipient must be:

- an author of an accepted paper and be registered for the conference,
- a full-time student regularly registered toward a degree in computer science, engineering or related field at a university,

To apply for a grant, complete the information in the form below and obtain your advisor's endorsement & signature. The completed application form along with your scanned Student ID card should be submitted as a single pdf file to Dr. Dong (nas2014\_student\_grant@nscc-tj.gov.cn) with the subject "NAS 2014 Student Travel Assistance Grant". The file name should include your full name. Application should be submitted by July 20, 2014. Early application will be more likely to receive the grant.
